Lady Lake Police are investigating recent fraud cases where local seniors were tricked into sending money after receiving phone calls from imposters.



#### HOW TO AVOID THE SCAM

- Block unwanted calls and text messages.
- Don't give out your personal information in response to a request that you didn't expect. Honest organizations won't call, email, or text to ask for your personal information, like your Social Security, bank account, or credit card numbers.
- Resist the pressure to act immediately. Anyone who pressures you to pay or give them your personal information is a scammer.

#### NEVER PAY SOMEONE WHO INSISTS YOU CAN ONLY PAY WITH:


- Cryptocurrency
