

LADY LAKE CHRISTMAS PARADE

The Town's annual Christmas Parade will be held Saturday, Dec. 6 at 10 a.m. along Old Dixie Highway. This year's theme, "Santa's Toy Workshop," will bring to life the magic of the North Pole with festive floats, holiday characters and cheerful Christmas music.

Residents should be aware of the following road closures for the duration of the event: Clay Avenue

and W. Lady Lake Boulevard will be closed to through traffic beginning at 9 a.m. County Road 466 between Rolling Acres Road and US Highway 27/441 will close at 9:45 a.m. County Road 466 between Rolling Acres Road and Hwy 27/441 will close at 9:45 a.m. The roads surrounding the Staging Area will close at 8:30 a.m. These intersections, along with Old Dixie Highway, will remain closed for the duration of the parade. Parking is available at Snooky Park, 120 W. Lady Lake Blvd. and will be accessible via Lady Lake Blvd. only.

GROWTH MANAGEMENT'S NEW LOCATION

Growth Management Department has moved to a new, larger and more convenient location at the Municipal Annex located at 221 W. Guava St., next to the Lady Lake Library.

As always, most Growth Management services are available online, 24 hours a day by visiting www.ladylakefl.gov and clicking on Growth Management.

Online services include applying for permits, information or documentation needed to apply online, making payments, and filing or searching code cases.

All the same in-person services Growth Management provides will be available at the new location beginning Thursday, Nov. 20, including land use applications, rezoning, annexations, plan review, permitting, inspections, and code enforcement. Additionally, as an added benefit to the public, computers will be available in the lobby for searching permits or filling out permit applications.

A hotline will be open during normal business hours to assist customers during the transition and can be reached at 352-751-1511.



SOLAR-POWERED STOP SIGNS

Public Works installed solar-powered LED stop signs at the intersection of Old Dixie Highway and Lady Lake Boulevard. This is the second intersection in Town where the signs have been installed, followed by Rio Grande Avenue and Del Mar Drive in 2023.

"With the increase of foot traffic at Snooky Park, we wanted to enhance safety for pedestrians, especially during the Light Up Lady Lake event and the Christmas Parade on Dec. 6," said Public Works Director C.T. Eagle.
