

When property is turned into the police department after being found or abandoned, Florida statute allows it to be disposed of on its' scheduled purge date unless ownership can be proven. 


TRUTH IN MILLAGE (TRIM) NOTICE

The Lake County Property Appraiser sends the TRIM notice to all owners of property in Lake County, which includes those in the Town of Lady Lake. This notice details the taxes levied by each taxing authority on the property and the amount owed. It's essential for understanding your tax obligations.

The TRIM Notice is NOT a tax bill; it simply is intended to notify you of any changes in the valuation of your property and of the proposed taxes that may appear on the November Tax Bill. 
